ammendment, but now that we use it

EXT. SHACK

MAYOR:

EXT. TOWN OVERLOOK

TEACHER:

MAYOR:

And you could send him MORE pictures with a faster internet?

OLD LADY:

I like the purple monkey because he tells me the weather.

EXT. NEIGHBORHOOD

mayor is walking along a sidewalk.

MAYOR:

But it just isn't these special interest groups that use the internet. Normal hard working folk can come home and read movie reviews. With google's help they could actually stream movies, because NetFlix says our internet is too antiquated for their service. Here, let's go and just interview a random normal family.

(CONTINUED)

As the mayor walks up a driveway to an open garage he sees a black man inside of it. He quickly turns around and walks away hurriedly. The cameraman whispers loudly at him.

CAMERAMAN

MAYOR:

(hushed)

Are you sure? Shit.

one boob. I hear if you don't
switch off at regular intervals

MAYOR:

LADY:

reason I know not to give him the
vaccinations my doctors tried to
